If you create a free account on [Open Badge Passport](#) (OBP) you then can manage and share your badge online for example on social media . I don't see an email for my open badge.

The badge award email will go to the email account we have for you. To ensure that you can curate your badges, you can add multiple email addresses to your Open Badge Passport account and you will be able to pick up badges issued to any of your accounts once you have completed the email verification. **Please note, badge award emails are sometimes filtered into your spam folder so do check there.**

How do I show and share my badge?

First collect your badge and add it to a free Open Badge Passport (OBP) account. Make sure you have all the email accounts you use on your profile for OBP. You can then manage your badges under the Badges link > Social, adjust the settings, sharing using the social media links or embed code. You can now also use the badge QR code and add it to your email signature or on a CV or website.
