CABLES

- **HDMI**
 - Connects some devices, audio and video
- **VGA**
 - Connects from device video only
- **USB C**
 - New Apple MacBooks Audio, Video, Touchscreen
- **AUX**
 - Audio only
- **USB**
 - Touchscreen for BenQ

BEST PRACTICE FOR CONNECTING TO YOUR IFP WITHOUT INTERNET ACCESS

1. Use the wireless network and connect via InstaShare (there is a delay for dragging and dropping)
2. Hardwire without internet connection
 - a. USB C this is our newer MacBooks and will connect your audio, video, and touchscreen to navigate your device (InstaShare) NEWER MACBOOK
 - b. HDMI- for video and audio
 - i. USB for touch screen (InstaShare)
 - c. VGA (requires a dongle to connect to macbook) OLDER MACBOOK
 - i. AUX- for audio

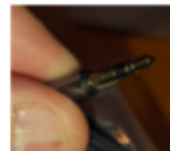

1. Power button
2. Laser pointer/Spotlight
3. Toggle between recently used apps
4. Settings
5. Control wheel
6. Home Button
7. Microphone Toggle
8. Undo/Go Back
9. Volume
10. Freeze/Blank (standby)



FRONT OF YOUR BOARD

Right Side-

1. Power/Standby (preferred) button
2. Home Button
3. Go Back
4. Settings
5. Volume Down
6. Volume Up
7. USB- Touchscreen
8. HDMI- Audio, Video
9. USB-C Audio, Video, Touchscreen
10. USB port (Flash drives, USB connections)
11. USB port (Flash drives, USB connections)
12. NFC Reader (scan spot for your badge)



BACK OF YOUR BOARD

****IF YOU HAVE SOMETHING PLUGGED IN AND YOU DO NOT KNOW WHAT IT IS, DON'T UNPLUG!****

It is likely the wireless dongle which allows the device to connect to the network

1. USB- Touchscreen (Input 1) PREFERRED
2. HDMI- Audio, Video (Input 1) PREFERRED
3. USB- Touch Screen (input 2)
4. HDMI- Audio, Video (Input 2)
5. VGA- Audio
6. AUX- Audio
