Summary Report

Ganesh Chaturthi, also known as Vinayaka Chaturthi or Vinayaka Chaviti or Ganeshotsav is a Hindu festival commemorating the birth of the Hindu god Ganesha. The festival is marked with the installation of Ganesha's clay murtis privately in homes and publicly on elaborate pandals. Observances include chanting of Vedic hymns and Hindu texts, such as prayers and vrata (fasting). Offerings and prasada from the daily prayers, that are distributed from the pandal to the community, include sweets such as modaka as it is believed to be a favourite of Ganesha. The festival ends on the tenth day after start, when the idol is carried in a public procession with music and group chanting, then immersed in a nearby body of water such as a river or sea, called visarjan on the day of Anant Chaturdashi.

On the D-day Ganesha's idol was bought by the Rotaract team members. The first day pooja of Ganesha was done at 11.30 pm. All the required materials for the pooja were bought by the team members. Everyday we have invited a particular staff member to do Ganesha's pooja. If the staff member is unavailable then we team members use to continue the pooja. We had a poojari for all 8 days pooja of Ganesha ji. Everything related to pooja was done under his guidance. On 3rd of September i.e. on 4th day of Ganesh Chaturthi the Annadhanam program was conducted with a huge support of our KG REDDY college. Everyday the Ganesh pooja was done around 10am-11.30 am. On the last day of Ganesh Chaturthi in the morning we around 11.30 we have done Ganesh ji pooja and we have conducted Dahi Handi program after that Ganesh laddu velam was done the Ganesh ji laddu was successfully taken over by Sai from first year at 20333. After this session the last session was about to begin before that we made Ganesh ji to seat in the vehicle to leave for Ganesh ji visarjan. Then we had a 90 min of DJ dance while sending of Ganesh during this we also distributed the prasada to all



the devotess present there. Finally some members of our team went for ganesh visarjan at chilkur village lake. Reaminig students and staff members went to their respective college buses. The college busses at left at 4:30pm ending the successful Celebrations of ganesh chaturthi.
