Important Note:

Two (2) applications must be submitted in order to be considered for admission to the PK-3 ECE Specialist Instruction Credential Program (one (1) department application and one (1) University application).

All items listed below, unless otherwise noted, must be submitted by the application deadline of April 1. Bachelor Degree must be conferred before the program begins. After submitting an initial program application, updated documents for the Department Application file should be emailed to csscdocuments@csueastbay.edu with full name, program name, and start term in the subject line.

☐	Early Field Experience Verification Form(s) verifying minimum of 45 hours of field experience with groups of students within the last 5 years, 15 hours in a public/private-school classroom.
☐	Bachelor Degree from a regionally accredited institution: On the Department Application, list the school and degree major where the Bachelor Degree was completed, for example, B.A. degree in Human Development from CSU East Bay. If the Bachelor Degree is in progress, indicate this and the planned graduation/conferral date in the space below. ☐ Bachelor Degree in Progress (mark if yes) Planned Graduation/Conferral Date: _____
☐	Grade Point Average (GPA) If GPA is below the 2.67 minimum, you may be required to submit a GPA waiver.
☐	University Application (Cal State Apply)
☐	Tuberculosis (TB) Clearance: Negative TB Test: Risk Assessment is NOT acceptable.
