- Members with less than four (4) previous SUPRS races must start tail regardless of time trial or handicap.
- SUPRS Rulebook shall govern all race procedures including, but not limited to, formats, race length, penalties, etc.

Time Trials-Winged Supermodifieds

- 1. All competitors entered shall make a time trial attempt.
- 2. Each competitor shall be given two laps under time. The faster of the two laps under time shall be deemed the official time for that car.
- 3. Competitors not making a Time Trial attempt shall automatically start at the tail of heat.
- 4. Competitors that are not within two and a half, (2.5), seconds of the fastest qualifier must start tail of all events.

Heat Races-Winged Supermodifieds

- 1. ALL COMPETITORS MUST RUN QUALIFYING HEAT RACES
- 2. If less than 24 cars entered there shall be two heat races.
- 3. All competitors that have time trialed within the top 12, shall run a qualifying Heat Race.
- 4. Slow/Fast Heat Race format shall be used.
- 5. There shall be one Slow Heat Race and one Fast Heat Race.
 - a. Slow Heat Race shall be heat one and shall include the slowest half of the total amount of qualified cars.
 - b. Fast Heat Race shall be heat two and shall include the fastest half of the total amount of qualified cars.
 - c. Both heats shall be fully inverted with the slowest car of each group, (slow/fast), starting from the pole position.
- 6. Top four(4) finishers shall transfer to feature and get their time trial back and be eligible for feature inversion.
- 7. Top six finishers shall transfer to feature.
- 8. When B-Main is needed, (19 or more cars entered) those finishing out of top 6 will advance to B-main to attempt to qualify for A-main.
- 9. If fewer than 18 cars are entered to race there shall be no B-Main
- 10. Heat races shall be no more than 8 laps in length and shall start no more than 12 cars.

HEAT LINE UP EXAMPLE-

SUPRS Option-

- 1. Once the Time Trials and Heat Races have finished, a provisional starter may be added to the SUPRS Copper World Classic XVI presented by Kern Motorsports lineup according to the SUPRS Option rule.
- 2. The driver with the most points of the 2019-20 SUPRS Gold Crest Wing Championship XVI season point standings as of 03/30/2020, who has not already used their SUPRS Option and has failed to qualify for the feature event, may be added to the tail of the qualified cars.
- 3. The B-Main shall transfer one less car.

B-Main-

- 1. B-Main qualifying race will be run if 19 or more cars are entered.
- 2. B-Main shall be lined up according to Heat Race finish with "Slow" heat starting on the inside row.
- 3. B-Main shall be used to fill the remaining positions for 20 car field.
- 4. Race shall be no more than 12 laps in length.

Feature-Wing Supermodifieds

- 1. Top 4 finishers of each Heat Race shall be inverted based on times by pill draw.
- 2. Pills number 4, 6, 8 shall be used.
- 3. Remaining heat cars shall start feature 'straight up' based on their heat finish with "slow heat" finishers starting on inside row.
- 4. B-Main cars shall start 'straight up' based on their finish behind all other qualified cars.
- 5. Feature race shall be 25 laps in length.

Points-

Full Feature points and normal bonus schedule shall be paid for wing supermodifieds

Time Trials-Non-Wing Supermodifieds

- 1. All competitors entered shall make a time trial attempt.
- 2. Each competitor shall be given two laps under time. The faster of the two laps under time shall be deemed the official time for that car.
- 3. Competitors not making a Time Trial attempt shall automatically start at the tail of feature.
- 4. Competitors that are not within two and a half, (2.5), seconds of the fastest qualifier must start tail of all events.
- 5. If there are more than 19 cars entered to race, the top 12 qualifiers shall be locked into the feature event with remaining cars sent to B-Main.

Heat Races-Non-Wing Supermodifieds

1. There shall be no Heat Races for non-wing supermodifieds

SUPRS Option-

- Once the Time Trials have finished, a provisional starter may be added to the SUPRS Copper World Classic XVI presented by Kern Motorsports lineup according to the SUPRS Option rule.
- 2. The driver with the most points of the 2019-20 SUPRS Gold Crest Wing Championship XVI season point standings as of 03/30/2020, who has not already used their SUPRS

Option and has failed to qualify for the feature event, may be added to the tail of the qualified cars.

3. The B-Main shall transfer one less car.

B-Main-Non-Wing Supermodifieds

- 1. B-Main qualifying race will be run if 19 or more cars are entered.
- 2. B-Main shall be lined up according to the Time Trial position straight up with the fastest non-qualified car starting in pole position.
- 3. B-Main shall be used to fill the remaining positions for 20 car field with up to eight(8) cars transferring to feature.
- 4. Race shall be no more than 12 laps in length.

Feature-Non-Wing Supermodifieds

- 1. Elite 8 competitors shall be inverted based on times by pill draw.
- 2. Pills number 4, 6, 8 shall be used.
- 3. Remaining cars shall start feature 'straight up' based on their qualifying time.
- 4. B-Main cars shall start 'straight up' behind all other qualified cars.
- 5. Feature race shall be 25 laps in length.

Points:

Standard Time Trial Points Shall be Paid

Standard Feature Race Points Shall be Paid

Bonuses:

Standard Bonus Points Shall be Paid

SUPRS Copper World Classic Champion

- 1. Feature finish points shall be tallied from wing and non-wing races.
- 2. Driver with the most points total shall be deemed SUPRS Copper World Classic XVI Champion.
- 3. Tie-Breaker shall be best highest feature finish, then highest heat race finish, then fastest time trial lap for wing, then fastest time trial lap for non-wing.
