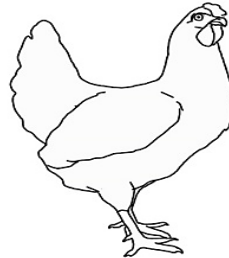

**WHAT TO KNOW!****Consonant Digraphs**

A **digraph** is when two consonants come together in a word and the letters stand for one sound.

Digraphs can be found at the beginning, at the middle, or at the end of a word.

Examples: c-h /ch/ chicken



s-h /sh/ sheep
