Event Rules & Guidelines

- Teams must have at least 6 participants, at most 8 players
 - All players must follow standard volleyball rules (reference if needed: <https://www.theartofcoachingvolleyball.com/basic-volleyball-rules-and-terminology/>)
 - All players must rotate clockwise, and all must serve

Are there any rules for team composition?

- All teams must be co-ed and consist of 6 to 8 players, with 6 players on the court at a time (accommodations may apply). At least one player on the court must be a girl at all times. During every play, a girl must make contact with the ball at least once; failure to do so will result in a point being awarded to the opposing team. Substitutions are allowed and will follow standard volleyball rules.

What happens if we don't have a full team?

- Individual participants can still join! We will help place you on a team to make sure everyone can play and have fun.

Are there prizes for winners?

- Yes! Winning teams will receive prizes and recognition during the award ceremony at the end of the event.
