February 2025

- 17th Feb - **A Cruel Love: The Ruth Ellis Story** (ITV mini-series) - Follows the story of Ruth Ellis: her lifestyle as a young nightclub manageress, her violent relationship with the man she then killed in cold blood, her arrest, trial, and subsequent legal battle to get her release before she was hanged.
- 21st Feb - **A Thousand Blows** (Disney series) - Set in 1850's East London, a series about a gang of female boxers during the industrial revolution, which will star Stephen Graham as boxer Henry "Sugar" Goodson.
- 22nd Feb - **Dope Girls** (BBC One series) - It follows the birth of the nightclub scene in London's Soho.
- 23rd Feb - **1923** (Paramount Series) - The next instalment of the Yellowstone origin story, set in 1923, starring Harrison Ford and Helen Mirren.
- 27th Feb - **Toxic Town** (Netflix mini-series) - The tragic toxic waste case in the East Midlands and three mothers fighting for the justice for the rates of upper limb defects in babies born in Corby were subsequently found to be three times higher than those of children born.

March 2025

- **2nd March - Towards Zero** (BBC One series) - Superintendent Battle and Inspector Leach probe the killing of a widow in Gull's Point. A failed suicide, a false theft charge, and a tennis star's love life surprisingly connect, culminating in the revelation of a murder plot.
- **5th March - The Leopard** (Netflix series) A 19th-century Sicilian aristocratic family gets caught up in the changing sociopolitical times.
- **5th March - Miss Scarlet Season 5** (Alibi series) - Nineteenth-century crime drama about the first-ever female detective in Victorian London, now without "The Duke" from Season 5.
- **9th March - Belgravia: The Next Chapter** (ITV series) - 25 years after the events of the previous show, scandals continue to plague this family
- **9th March - Ten Pound Poms S2** (BBC series) - A group of Brits leave post-war Britain in 1956 to embark on an adventure. The Roberts family tries to make the best of their situation, but life at the shelter tests them, but they're not the only ones avoiding the truth.

September 2025

- **12th Sept - Downton Abbey 3** (movie)
- **26th Sept - The Bride** (movie) - In 1930s Chicago, Frankenstein asks Dr. Euphronius to help create a companion. They give life to a murdered woman as the Bride, sparking romance, police interest, and radical social change.

Sometime in 2025 or later

The Abandons (Netflix series) – When a corrupt force of wealth and power covets the lands of a group of diverse and atypical families and tries to drive them out, they must pursue their Manifest Destiny.

Assassination (movie) – The film will reimagine JFK's death, with Giancana responsible for ordering the hit, believing that the president attempted to undermine the mob, despite their help in his election.

The Christie Affair (series) – A reimagining of Agatha Christie's 11-day disappearance in 1926, which mirrored many elements of the mystery genre the late author was known for.

The Damned (movie) – The film follows Eva, a 19th-century widow who is tasked with making an impossible choice when, in the middle of an especially cruel winter, a ship sinks off the coast of her isolated fishing post.

The Dreadful – Set against the backdrop of the War Of The Roses, Anne and her mother Morwen live a solitary, harsh life on the outskirts of society. But when a man from their past returns, he will set off a sequence of events that become a turning point for Anne.

Frankenstein (Netflix movie) – Dr. Pretorius tracks down Frankenstein's monster, who is believed to have died in a fire forty years before, in order to continue the experiments of Dr. Victor Frankenstein.

Hamnet (movie) – The story of Agnes – the wife of William Shakespeare – as she struggles to come to terms with the loss of her only son, Hamnet. A human and heart-stopping story as the backdrop to the creation of Shakespeare's most famous play, Hamlet.

The History of Sound (movie) – Two young men during World War I set out to record the lives, voices and music of their American countrymen.

The Hood (movie) – Benedict Cumberbatch will play a farmer who becomes the leader of the Peasant's Revolt.

House of Guinness (Netflix series) – House of Guinness will focus on the consequences of the death of Benjamin Guinness, the man responsible for the success of the Guinness brewery.

An Ideal Wife (movie) – Follows the life of Constance Lloyd, leading light in the anti-corset movement and wife of Oscar Wilde, exploring the sexual awakening she experienced when she discovered that Wilde was homosexual.

The Immortal Man (Netflix movie) – The final Peaky Blinders movie

Irena Sendler (movie) – The story of Polish nurse and social worker Irena Sendler, and her activities with the Polish Underground Resistance in German-occupied Warsaw during World War 2.

King and Conqueror (BBC series) – William of Normandy and Harold of Wessex were two individuals destined to meet at the Battle of Hastings in 1066; they were allies but had no claim to the British monarchy until fate drove them into a conflict over the country's crown.

Madfabulous (movie) - A riotous, uncompromising celebration of otherness inspired by the unlikely British aristocrat who bankrupted his estate, lived fast and died young.

Me, You (movie) - On a remote Italian island in the early 1960s, a teenage boy haunted by memories of the war falls in love with an older girl who holds a dark secret. Based on the novel "Tu, Mio," by Erri De Luca.

Marty Supreme (movie) - The story of American table tennis legend Marty Reisman. Starring Timothee Chalamet.

Mary's Monster (movie) - Terrified of giving voice to the darkness of her subconscious mind, Mary Shelley locks into a dangerous battle with her own 'inner monster' as she struggles to write her seminal science fiction novel, Frankenstein.

Monstrous Beauty (movie) - Barbara is Born with a rare condition she is entirely covered in hair. She is offered a place in the luxurious court of King Charles II. Barbara aspires to become a playwright under the famous actress Nell Gwyn powerful mistress to the King.

Mrs Churchill (mini-series) - a drama series based on the public and private life of Clementine Churchill, wife of British Prime Minister Sir Winston Churchill.

Nell Gwyn (movie) - A dramatisation of the life of Nell Gwyn, mistress of Charles II.

Not Bloody Likely (movie) - Based on the true story behind George Bernard Shaw's masterpiece Pygmalion. Starring Helena Bonham Carter and Pierce Brosnan.

The Odyssey (movie) - Follows Odysseus in his perilous journey home after the Trojan War, showcasing his encounters with Polyphemus, the Sirens, Circe, and finishing with his reunion with his wife, Penelope.

Outrageous (TV series) - Based on the story of the Mitford sisters, six sisters who refused to play by the rules and whose often-scandalous lives made headlines around the world. Set in the 1930s, it is a tale of betrayal, scandal, heartache and even imprisonment.

Sherlock & Daughter - (TV series) Sherlock Holmes faces a sinister case risking friends' lives. American Amelia joins, seeking her father after her mother's murder. Despite differences, they solve a conspiracy and her mother's case.

A Special Relationship (movie) - A new biopic about Hollywood legend Elizabeth Taylor.

War Magician (movie) - The wild story of Jasper Maskelyne, a British illusionist who used magic to defeat Erwin Rommel in World War II.

The War Rooms (mini-series) - Follows the women who worked in Winston Churchill's secret bunker in Whitehall, central London.

The Whalebone Theatre (mini-series) - A ravishing coming-of-age story set in the shadow of an oncoming war, an 'unmarriageable' girl elects to defy convention and find her own path through life.

Winter Palace (Netflix series) - In 1899, Andre Morel envisions a luxury hotel open all winter. He convinces Lord Fairfax to partner. Together they work to open the hotel, battling demanding guests, rebellious staff and harsh weather.

Young Sherlock (Amazon series) - A 19-year-old Sherlock Holmes, finds himself entangled in a murder at Oxford that jeopardizes his freedom. His first case, tackled recklessly, leads him to uncover a far-reaching conspiracy that alters his path forever.
