

Beagle Food To Avoid Health Risks



A Beagle can effectively consume large quantities of food, but the problem is the dog tends to put on weight. You wouldn't like to see a fat, ugly Beagle with poor health. Beagles can consume food quickly and do not specifically have preferences for certain types of food. A strong sense of smell sometimes takes the Beagle to unwanted places in search for food. Dog owners therefore are in a predicament as to how much they need to feed their pets in order to prevent them from getting into dangerous situations.

Feed A Bit More Than Required

You may need some time to gauge the amount of food your Beagle can eat. It's a safe bet to feed your dog a bit more than the standard recommendation. For example, a cup or two of high-quality food is all that is required. A Beagle is small and weighs approximately 20 - 30 pounds. So it does not require more. Feed the dog two whole cups initially to check if it gains weight. Exercise the Beagle a bit more until it is tired and sleepy.

The earlier you start, the faster you realize how much food is required. Ideally, you house train your Beagle as a puppy and then follow standard instructions to feed the dog. Compensate with additional goodies as part of the obedience training program. In other words, the more positive your dog turns out to be, the more goodies it gets. Care should be taken to avoid addiction or dependence on food items outside normal meals.

Exactly What Should You Feed a Beagle Puppy

Until the puppy is eight weeks old, it requires mother's milk for nutritious sustenance. Solid food should be introduced when the dog is around five weeks old. It is the right time to get your Beagle used to home-made food. Non-vegetarians do not have much to do, except feed their dogs soft meat mixed with cooked rice and vegetables. Sharp chicken bones must be avoided. Commercial Beagle food contains preservatives not really essential for the dog.

People often add milk substitutes to normal food to create a wet broth. The Beagle puppy adapts better and is generally satisfied with the meal. Milk substitutes can be slowly substituted with the same quantity of solid food. Sufficient fat must be included in the food, or it may cause health concerns including lethargy and obesity.

Useful Info About Adult Dog Food

Housebreaking is an important aspect of training the dog to live peacefully in your home. The Beagle needs to understand that consuming food is part of a regular routine and must therefore be fed just enough quantity to keep it satisfied throughout the day. Commercial food does contain some unwanted additives. Effectively, it means you have to feed the dog more than required.
