- Link Crew: Year-long mentoring program helps 9th graders transition to high school
- CollegeTracks: Supports first generation college-bound students
- AP/IB/TOEFL Support: Expands access to more students by covering program fees
- **Professional Development**: Underwrites 100% of teacher grants to attract and retain the best faculty
- **Summer Programs**: Funds a wide range of academic-boosting programs, historically including a college essay workshop, girls' leadership initiative, 9th and 10th grade academies, and ESOL support
