

7TH GRADE ART SUPPLY LIST

- A sketchbook is highly recommended to keep your work together as you complete the sketchbook assignments, but you can get by without it.
- Unlined white paper (printer paper is OK!)
- Thicker paper (watercolor or multimedia paper that can handle a little water)
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Glue
- Eraser (white plastic works best)
- Pencil (a plain #2 non-mechanical is great)
- Fine Line Permanent Marker (the fine point Sharpie-type works great)
- Acrylic or Tempera paints (water soluble, but opaque)
- Plastic palette or plate to mix paint on
- Watercolor paints
- Paintbrushes (the ones that come with the paint is fine)
- One package of polymer or air dry clay (option for a project in 2nd semester)
- Aluminum foil, heavy cardboard, thin cardboard or heavy paper OR black construction paper and thick permanent black marker
- Printer - You'll need this to print some images
- Digital camera (one on a phone is great) or scanner to capture images of your work to submit

These materials are the minimum requirements. You will have opportunities to use other supplies if you would like!
