Facts of the Case:

p. 130 Worcester v. Georgia

1832 There was a priest whose name was Samuel Worcester he came to teach the Cherokee indians in Georgia how to defend themselves from being moved. But Georgia did not allow white men to be in Indian Territory (unless they gave you a license). They would not give Samuel a license and so they arrested Samuel and he was put into prison with 4 years of hard labor. He asked the Supreme Court to review his case.

The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, John Marshall), decided that the Indians could not be moved from their land.
