# **Target Age Groups and Course Realms**

Both programs welcome children entering **grades K-9**. Submitting proposals that can be **adapted across multiple age groups** increases the probability of selection for both programs.

Sheldon Institute	Children and adolescents entering grades K-9	Arts/Crafting/Music, Sciences/Technology, Sports/Wellness, Hobbies/Gaming, Deep dives into specific topics (e.g., Language studies, history, cryptography), or any other creative course topic.	
STEAM Camp	Children and adolescents entering grades K-9	Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math (STEAM). Courses should be interactive, hands-on, and focus on real-world applications.	

### **Mandatory Instructor Requirements**

All selected applicants must complete the following prior to the program start date:

- Attend a paid Instructor Orientation.
- Submit information for a check through the NYS Sex Offender Registry.
- Attend a mandatory virtual child protection training.

#### **Compensation and Materials**

- Pay Rate: Instructors will be compensated at a rate of \$30 per hour for each week of lesson(s) taught, including compensation for attending orientation.
- Material Cost: Instructors must be mindful of costs, and will be given a very limited budget, as neither program charges extra material fees for courses. Instructors are encouraged to use materials in the program inventory.
- Proposal Cost Details: Course proposals need to include the estimated material cost
  per student, along with any equipment costs and an assessment of how essential the
  equipment is to run the course. Please be advised that each instructor only has a budget
  of \$100 per program (Sheldon Institute and STEAM Camp).

#### **Instructor Responsibilities**

- Course Planning & Development: Plan the course content, manage instructional materials and logistics, and ensure activities adhere to the established supply budget.
- Instruction & Delivery: Develop and deliver diverse, engaging, STEAM-based activities specifically tailored to the assigned grade level(s).
- Student Management & Supervision: Maintain continuous supervision of students, manage a consistent group (up to 12 children) for the duration of the program, and foster continuity and positive group dynamics.
- Environment: Establish and maintain a safe, inclusive, and fun learning environment for all participants.

## <u>Application Instructions: Course Proposal and Resume Submission</u>

To apply for the Youth Program Instructor position, the applicant must submit a resume and a complete course proposal via the required Google Form.

- How to Apply
  - o Prepare Your Documents:
    - Resume: Ensure your resume is current.
    - Course Proposal(s): Prepare your proposal as a separate document (PDF or Word) including all required information (listed below) and any other relevant details pertaining to the course.
  - o Access the Application Form: Fill out the required information by clicking the link to the official Google Form.
  - o Submit Your Materials: Within the Google Form, you will be prompted to:
    - Attach your Course Proposal.
    - Attach your Resume.
    - Submit the Google Form.

#### **Course Proposal Requirements**

Course proposals must include at least the following information to be considered:

- Name of the Proposed Course
- Brief Description of the Proposed Course (e.g., goals, learning objectives)
- Brief Daily Outline of Proposed Course (e.g., activities planned for each session/day)
- At Least One Age Group that this course would be facilitated for: K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-7
- Estimated Supplies Needed (Note: There will be no more than 12 children in your group.)

### **Course Proposal Submission**

- **Submission Deadline:** The highest consideration will be given to proposals submitted before **March 1, 2026**. *Applications are accepted on a rolling basis*.
- Content: Courses must be interactive and engaging.

• **How to Submit:** Proposals should be submitted electronically via the appropriate Instructor webpage (Sheldon Institute or STEAM Camp).
