Principals' Report


- Teacher Appreciation, Animal Assembly



Open Forum

- Dedicated Social Chairs to oversee Social Media channels + PTO Website in 2025/26 (2-3 people)

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We have spent time over the last few years benchmarking other PTO/PSO organizations to assess best practices, optimal structure and processes. Currently we have a single Treasurer on our executive board. After review, we are putting to a vote the addition of a second treasurer to the Executive Board. Below is a description of the newly created position.

Position Title - Co-Treasurer

Responsibilities -

1. Checks and Balances- Dual oversight helps prevent errors, fraud or misuse of funds. Ensures accountability with two sets of eyes reviewing financial activities. Builds trust with parents and school staff.
2. Division of Labor- One Treasurer can focus on the day-to-day tasks (receipts, reimbursements, etc.). The second Treasurer can focus on reporting, budgeting, audits, working with the accountant and maintaining licenses. (Prior financial experience a plus). The Treasurer role can be demanding and is critical to every single fundraiser and event. Having a second Treasurer can help to divide the overall responsibilities.
3. Continuity and Backup- If one Treasurer is unavailable (illness, emergency, vacation, etc), the other can step in and provide seamless support. Ease of transition when one Treasurer's term is up so that have proper support in place.

PTO

Voting - Co-Treasurer would have full voting rights. This would give us a 6th voting member, in the event of a tie in an executive board vote the Principal would be the tie-breaker.

Co-Treasurer Term - Term would be 2 years, alternating with each other. In the event that a Co-Treasurer does not fulfill their term of service, a replacement would be voted in to finish out that term. A new election would then be held to keep the positions on alternating terms.

Adding a second Treasurer is a proactive step that strengthens our PTO, improves transparency, and protects both our volunteers and the funds entrusted to us. We recommend updating our bylaws to allow for this position so we can begin the recruitment and appointment as soon as possible.

Voting Rules -

1. Voting will be done in person, via anonymous ballot.
2. You must have paid PTO dues this year (July 1 2024 - June 30th 2025) to vote.
3. Only one vote per house hold. Parents living in separate may cast 2 votes as long as EACH parent has paid their PTO Dues.
