

How to check out eBooks:

To read our Follett eBooks, here is a simple “how-to” to get you started with all devices across all platforms:

Login to the library web site just as you would to look at the catalog at school (regular username and password). Go to this site: <http://www.lmc.kearney.k12.mo.us/> and choose Kearney Junior High. The log-in button is in the top right-hand corner of the KJH LMC Home screen. Once logged in, choose the Catalog tab on the top left. Be sure you are in a “basic” search. Under “material type,” use the drop down arrow to choose “electronic book.” Put your cursor in the search bar and hit “enter.” This will bring up all eBook titles that are in our library.

The eBooks will have a green symbol that looks like this:



Choose a book to read and click on the title. Choose to “check it out” or “download” to your device. Your eBook will be checked out to your account for four weeks. To access your eBook, when you go to the library homepage, you need to login. Then go to “My Info.” Your eBooks will show up there and be available to read.

One feature of the eBooks is the ability to use various tools with each page in the book. Text can be highlighted, there is a dictionary feature, ways to bookmark pages, etc.

We also offer eBooks from **Gumdrop** and **MackinVIA**. They can be accessed as described above. In case of a glitch, the direct links for these eBooks are located on the library homepage below the large Symbaloo grid. Use the following username and password information to access them on your device:

Gumdrop—username: kearneyjh password: dawgs

MackinVia—username: KJHS password: bulldogs

Those credentials will work for everyone. MackinVia eBooks should not require the login credentials. This is a new feature for Follett. I included password information, just in case there is a glitch in the system. Ah, technology!
