The last letter of a word works as the first letter of the next word. For example **SON>NEAR>RAN**. After spelling a word, press enter to submit it. The hyphenated words and proper nouns are not allowed in the puzzle. The game's editor, Sam Ezersky, selects the words for the answers. So, all the words in the list of answers are not included.

Where To Play

The NYT fans can enjoy the puzzle in the Games app, at the games menu of the official website, or in the Play tab of the New York Times News app. You can approach any of these platforms to enjoy your favorite puzzle.

When To Play

A new puzzle is released at 3 a.m. Eastern Time Standard every day of the week. Users enjoy the puzzle every day before the next puzzle is released.

Winning Strategies

These are some tips to play and win the game efficiently. These are the hints to understand the pattern of the NYT Letter Boxed game.

- Players are allowed to ***create at least 3 letters long words.***
- ***Don't stick to the letters on the same side.***
- ***Identify the familiar words*** of daily use.
- Utilise the ***uncommon letters*** earlier.
- Utilize the ***Prefixes and Suffixes.***
- ***Be prepared for the next words*** simultaneously.
- ***Reset the puzzle*** to try again.
- Look back to the ***last day's puzzle answers.***
- ***Explore new words*** that you don't know.
