Homework/Classwork - Formative Assessments (40%)

- Warm Up
 - Every day will begin with a warm up.
 - The warm up sheet will be picked up on the way into class on the first day of the school week.
 - The warm up is completed at the beginning of class individually or quietly with a classmate. After 3 – 5 minutes, we will discuss the warm up as a whole class.
 - The warm up sheet is turned in on the last day of the school week and is graded on work shown and correct answers.

Homework

- Every new lesson will include at least one homework assignment.
- The number of homework problems will vary depending on the difficulty of the lesson.
- Each homework assignment is worth 5 points (unless noted otherwise)
 and is graded on accuracy, completion AND work shown.
- It is your responsibility to get extra homework copies. There are 2 ways to do so:
 - You can grab a copy yourself in the extra homework folder.
 - You ask Ms. Didier (or another adult) with a copy of your missing assignment report.
- Late work is due by the middle of the trimester if assigned prior to mid-trimester or the end of the trimester if assigned after mid-trimester and is worth at least 60%.

CFUs, Interims / Summative Assessments (60%)

• Check for Understanding (CFU)

- Students will be given an assessment after the end of each unit, known as a CFU (check for understanding).
- The number of assessment problems will vary depending on difficulty.
- Students are allowed to use their math notes and/or multiplication tables on the assessment. Calculators will only be allowed on specific assessments.
- All students are allowed to complete corrections on all CFUs (given their score is < 100%). Accurate corrections will be worth half credit.

Interims

- Students will take closed note interim assessments throughout the year.
 These assessments are cumulative, and proceed with (typically) 3 days of review.
 - With each interim is a paper study guide. It is your responsibility to keep track of your study guide. Only a certain number of study guides will be printed, and will be located on the front table.
 - Each study guide will be worth 10 summative (test) points and are due the day of the interim.
