

Here are all the forms for each of the numbers one to ten!

First, the nine forms for 'one', prefaced by the class of thing they modify:

Legendary (gods, spirits, legendary creatures): **ηψihayvay** [ηψ<sup>h</sup>æjv<sup>h</sup>æj] (<ψ> represents a retroflex click, for which there's no IPA symbol)

Human: **ηlivay** [η<sup>l</sup>i<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>æj]

Zoic (animals): **ηuväy** [k<sup>h</sup>ú<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>äj]

Natural Phenomena (celestial bodies, weather, fire): **!whavay** [g<sup>h</sup>!w<sup>h</sup>æ<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>æj]

Vegetal (plants): **mbivay** [mb<sup>h</sup>i<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>æj]

Liquid: **šoväy** [s<sup>h</sup>ó<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>äj]

Instrument (tools, weapons, clothing, equipment): **ndziväy** [ndz<sup>h</sup>ü<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>äj]

Lustrous (light emitters and reflectors): **zìjvay** [z<sup>h</sup>i<sup>h</sup>j<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>æj]

Miscellaneous (everything else): **ηloväy** [η<sup>l</sup>ó<sup>h</sup>v<sup>h</sup>äj]

Pronunciations written in the International Phonetic Alphabet are in the brackets.

The root for 'one' is the same as the root for 'finger or toe; digit'

And now the other numbers. The rest of the numbers are in this format:

-numeral, followed by the meaning of the root. For example, 'five' is the same root as the word for 'hand'.

-animate form (begins in **ηwo**, plural of legendary, human, and zoic classes)

-natural form (begins in **vi**, plural of natural phenomenon, vegetal, and liquid classes)

-inanimate (begins in **qxä**, plural of instrument, lustrous, and miscellaneous classes)

-miscellaneous form (begins in **η!o**, used for numbers as abstract concepts rather than being used to count specific things, e.g. "five is greater than four")
