Legendary (gods, spirits, legendary creatures): ηψlhayvay [ηψlhàejv'hǎej] (<ψ> represents a retroflex click, for which there's no IPA symbol)

Human: η!livay [η]lí'vhǎej]

Zoic (animals): ‡uväy [k̄‡ú'vhǎej]

Natural Phenomena (celestial bodies, weather, fire): !whavay [ḡ!whâe'vhǎej]

Vegetal (plants): mbivay [mbhì'vhǎej]

Liquid: ŝoväy [soʻvhǎej]

Instrument (tools, weapons, clothing, equipment): ndzïväy [nd͡zhû'vhǎej]

Lustrous (light emitters and reflectors): **zi įvay** [z^ĥì j^ĥ 'v^ĥěj]

Miscellaneous (everything else): **ŋ!oväy** [ŋ!ɒʻvñǎj]

The root for 'one' is the same as the root for 'finger or toe; digit'

And now the other numbers. The rest of the numbers are in this format:

- -numeral, followed by the meaning of the root. For example, 'five' is the same root as the word for 'hand'.
- -animate form (begins in **‡wo**, plural of legendary, human, and zoic classes)
- -natural form (begins in vi, plural of natural phenomenon, vegetal, and liquid classes)
- -inanimate (begins in qxä, plural of instrument, lustrous, and miscellaneous classes)
- -miscellaneous form (begins in **ŋ!o**, used for numbers as abstract concepts rather than being used to count specific things, e.g. "five is greater than four")
