Back to School Message from School Nurse

As you prepare your student(s), please remember that it's important to keep your school nurse up to date on their health.

If you received a Health Condition Update form over the summer, please return it ASAP.

- If your student has a new health condition or medication prescribed to be taken during school hours, notify me ASAP: gail.boaz@evergreenps.org or 360-604-6675. There is paperwork that MUST be filled out before your student can have their medication at school.
- Students with potentially life-threatening health conditions (diabetes; asthma or allergies with rescue inhaler/EpiPen/Benadryl prescribed; seizures with emergency medication prescribed): Orders signed by the health care provider and a parent/guardian, and any prescribed medication MUST be received before your student can attend school. Any medication that will be kept at school must be brought in by a parent/guardian and signed in. Students without orders or needed medications will be SENT HOME.
