INTRODUCTION

The manuscript is written in English with Arial (11pt), 1 (one) column, 1.15 spacing, on A4 paper. Authors are asked to send in the form of files typed with MS-Word program and submitted via OJS by address <http://journal2.uad.ac.id/index.php/eshr/index>

The number of paragraphs is not limited but should include background, research objectives, research positions on previous research and novelty. A few theoretical foundations that are directly related to the content of articles can be included. It is not necessary to create a title (sub-chapters) in the introduction.

Files must be in MS Word only and should be formatted for direct printing, using the CRC MS Word. Figures and tables should be embedded and not supplied separately (1).

To avoid unnecessary errors, you are strongly advised to use the 'spellchecker' function of MS Word. Follow this order when typing manuscripts: Title, Authors, Affiliations, Abstract, Keywords, Main text (including figures and tables), Acknowledgements, References (4).

All **tables** should be numbered with Arabic numerals. Every table should have a caption. Headings should be placed above tables, left-justified. Only horizontal lines should be used within a table to distinguish the column headings from the table's body and immediately above and below the table. Tables must be embedded in the text and not supplied separately.

References must be listed at the end of the paper. Do not begin them on a new page unless this is necessary. Authors should ensure that every reference in the text appears in the list of references and vice versa. Indicate references by (1,2) or (1) in the text.
