SUBMITTING WORK ON CANVAS

1. You will submit your work online on CANVAS by the end of the work-month.

6. **Make sure the your handwriting is clear and big and legible in your submission, before you submit your work**
7. **Make sure the document is properly "shared" before submission (if it is a document/file that needs to be shared to district/teacher in order for them to access/see)**
8. **YOU are responsible for ensuring points are met before submitting your work online (or points will be taken off for either being late - 20% off total score, and/or points will be taken off based on the amount of work that staff members/myself cannot clearly see or verify)**
