

2026 Player Meeting:

Check in will be at the Lower Cato Falls Pavillion. If you're punching the park into your GPS, please be sure to put in LOWER CATO FALLS PARK, otherwise your GPS may try to take you to the upper side of the falls. You want LOWER cato falls.

Check in will be from 8-9am. If you're running late, please text me. We have quite a few groups of three, so if anyone isn't going to make it, I need to know ASAP so I can adjust accordingly and let those cardmates know of any changes. My number is 920-242-9887.

You will pick out your player pack at check in – as always for my event, any player that would like a player pack (regardless of division) is welcome to grab one. We have commemorative towels along with a variety of Spring Fling discs and items. Each person will get (1) towel and (2) other Spring Fling branded items of their choosing.

Raffle tickets will also be for sale. Thank you to Missy Anhalt for donating some beautiful hand-crafted crochet garments, and GRIP for donating merchandise to the raffle! We will have both a basket and a disc station rack in the raffle this year, so it's going to be a good one. All proceeds will go towards furthering the mission of our nonprofit, Lakeshore Ladies Disc Golf Corp. **(Share some of what we've done - clinic with Spanish foreign exchange students, girl scout troops clinics, school district carnival putting game, leagues, pro clinics, etc)**

We are going to do a group picture at 9am before everyone heads to their first tee. Photo will be taken near the pavilion.

All players will be asked to score the round, either on paper or on the PDGA live platform. At least one person from each card must live score so I can watch for backups or any concerns out on the course. You can either do so on the PDGA app, or at pdga.com/score. I highly recommend the app for ease of use. The access code for this event will be **SF2026**

Both Rounds: Lower Cato Falls Park

- Bottled water will be available on the course thanks to Festival Foods! There is also a water bottle refill station and bubbler at the pavilion.
- As always, I'll have a tacklebox in the pavilion bathroom with feminine products, hair ties, nail clippers, band-aids, and things of that nature. If you need something, grab it.
- There are three bathrooms on the course. There's a bathroom by the concession stand with running water. There is also an out-house style bathroom near the playground. And there is a portable toilet placed by Hole 7, thanks to a partnership with B&M Waste.
- There will be (3) holes with white flags for a longest putt. If you make a putt that is further from the basket than the current flag position, move the flag to the front of your previous lie and write your name on the card. Those flags will stay out there for BOTH rounds, so you have 6 chances to beat the distance on the flag! At the end of second round, if you end on a hole with the flag, please bring the flag in for us.
- FA4 and all Age Protected Amateur divisions will play short pads. Pro Divisions, FA1, and FA2 will play long pads.
- On or over any vehicular roads is OB. As always, the bluff that runs the north edge of the property will play as CASUAL. If you throw a shot that goes down the bluff, play the shot from the point where it went over the bluff, with NO penalty strokes. Again, it's casual, not OB. I just want you all to play safe. If you need help retrieving a disc that goes over the bluff, let our volunteers know and they can assist. I don't want anyone getting injured.

Lunch

If you purchased a taco lunch during registration, those lunches will be available for you as soon as you wrap up first round!

There is a challenge course at Cato that has 4 holes, each with it's own set of rules. Pick up the scorecard at the Cato concession stand and play at least two holes to be entered in for a prize drawing! You can do this during lunch OR during your pre-round warm up at the start of the day.

Awards

Trophies and black discs will be handed out to division winners after the last card comes in. I'm extremely excited to have 7 divisions that are black disc eligible! Raffles will be drawn and any Longest-Putt and Challenge Course prizes will be handed out immediately after that.

Door Disc Golf will be onsite vending, so check out what he's got available! All amateur payouts will be redeemed with Door Disc Golf.
