Fly-up day:

Started last year with 8th graders with good results.

8th graders will come to the high school on February 23rd this year to pick 5 classes (not core) exploring elective options. The students will be able to pick classes they want to explore and meet the teachers.

Parent Meeting was held to discuss this on Conference Day.

There will be a **Community Service Day** for grades 9-12 on February, 23rd. JT will be in charge. Stephanie Bowen will reach out to local businesses that will be open to students being able to get community service hours with them.

This is not required but will help.

Cassandra asked where they could get the paperwork for the Community Service hours.

She was advised the counselors office has those papers.

JT said this form should be put online for easier access.

Forecasting: Counselors created transcripts and worksheet for credits to be handed out in advisory today. 02/01/24.

It was stated by JT that we need to do parent square to let parents know about their student signing up for class schedules for next year.

Kurt said he will take Care of this.

Kurt stated that Legislators changed graduation requirements.

UP Coming Surveys:

Kurt answered, The Search survey gives us information about our student body. More realistic data on what really happens.

The SEED survey Is put out by the state.
