DOOR CANCER strives to make life a little easier for families affected by cancer. We hope to alleviate some of the suffering through financial assistance to people who are finding it a serious drain, not only in the area of medical care, but in other areas of their lives. DOOR CAN pays mortgages, insurance, utilities and other expenses, as well as providing food and gas cards to the applicant as needed.

Explanation of how you serve Northern Door County including primary programs your organization offers to the community.

We offer financial assistance to help families during cancer treatments pay their monthly bills. The bills don't stop coming just because you've had a health set back, we do not pay for medical bills or drugs. Financial Assistance is the only program we offer.

How would you define the impact your organization is making in Northern Door County?

We offer financial assistance at a time cancer patients need it most. During the first 6 months of 2018 alone, we have helped 11 Northern Door County residents, 26 times. The amounts total \$30,532.40, 3 of these 6 months the Northern Door cancer patients we have helped equals more than ½ of our monthly recipients (I am including information that only included applicants with addresses north of Sturgeon Bay) Applicants can re-apply each month as long as they are in active treatment, so most of these applicants have been help more than once. Our assistance only serves Door County, so our help runs from the southern Door county Line all the way to Washington Island

We help Door County residents in cancer treatments with non-medical bills. Almost all money raised goes to patients, we have no administrative costs and no paid employees and only Door County residents qualify.
