Created 2 classes and students will attend for 4 weeks as an intervention and then will return to their regular Advise class.
 - Jen Litzau- attendance: Chatfield instituted new policy- 90% attendance policy for unexcused absences. Below 90% you are not allowed to attend dances and non academic field trips. Positive behavior support team: reframing behavior policies; building a prevention and intervention manual.
