MAIN PRINCIPLE

The main principle I follow while working is "Do no harm" and I watch it carefully. When I feel that I have to go against it, I leave the place of work. I left many places. My last place was very special as finally I got what I wanted to have for a long time. It was two non-verbal low-functioning kids and I worked with them together. I observed interesting and positive changes in both boys in that new relationship. It was amazing..With one I used to work for years, but with another one just started.

For many years this boy spent his days in a vegetative half-sleepy state, staring in space. When I started to give him a lot of attention and stimulation with educational activities, he made huge changes. He became active and curious about the environment.

Environment did not like it as he started to bring trouble to those who cared for him most of the time- the staff of the residence, responsible for clients' well-being. Environment was not adjusted for those kids moving around independently. In most places where I worked with low functioning kids, the environment is almost empty or kids are watched carefully. Staff are responsible for their safety. The work is not easy with low pay and big responsibility. Naturally, nobody wants to get in trouble. Nobody

wants to make their job more difficult as it already is. So, no one was happy with those changes.

The SYSTEM is EVERYWHERE

In the given situation the mighty System got involved changing unwanted behavior with heavy medication and the boy became a real shaking vegetable and almost died, being overmedicated. I tried to fight asking approval for adjusting the environment a little bit for behavior change, but I lost that battle. The boy got another "treatment". So, I could not continue working there any more.

I decided to move to a country where the System of care was not developed and there was a big need for help. It seemed like favorable conditions for my situation. I got inspired by future possibilities, retired and moved to a country with beautiful nature, and its spirit seemed close to mine, hoping to help children and parents on a volunteer basis, while further developing my system.

Unfortunately, what people say and what they do often do not match. Not my skills or desire helping kids to progress with their lives were attracted to people, but my status being American and everything connected to that word in people's imagination, which is dollars. It was sad to learn about that (the story is described there- "Devil"s Jokes"

As a result of it I lost the residency and because of bureaucracy rules, covid regulations and some other reasons I had to relocate to another country.
