Overview

- Create a layout that mimics facebook (or another **highly structured** page)
- As before, submit either:
 - HTML file with internal CSS
 - zip archive containing HTML & CSS files

Tips

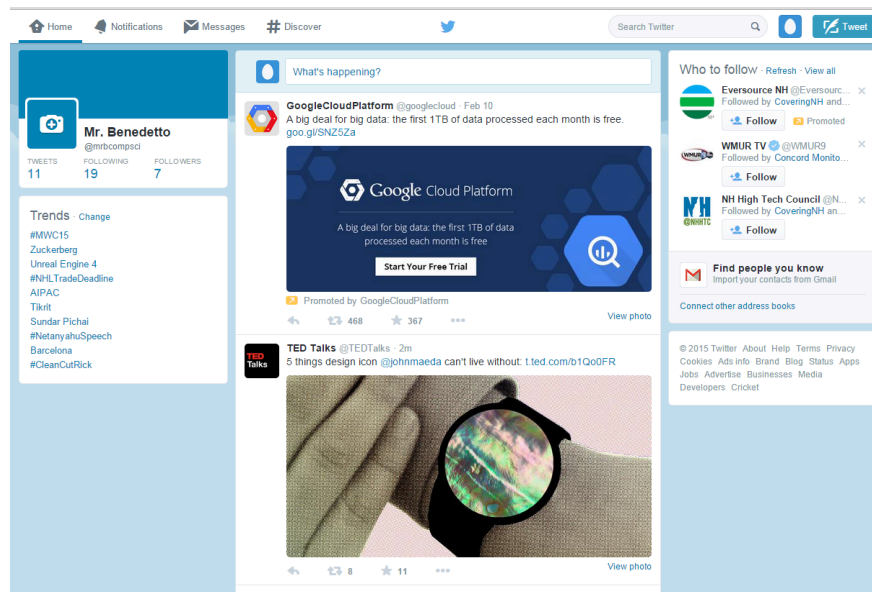
- Check out this template to get started:

- Notes on template
 - Define an absolute width for the page - the page should not shrink or grow when you resize the browser window.
 - Remember - you can **nest** divs and other content inside of other container divs.
- For the search input, use:
 - `<input type='text' placeholder='Search...'/>`

Requirements

- Top bar should be fully replicated, each column should have main components in place.
- Don't use screenshots unless you're capturing a specific image (for example, an icon).
- Don't worry about getting it "pixel perfect," just get as close as you can in a reasonable amount of time.
- Extension:
 - Use CSS3 @media queries to make a responsive page
