Enrolling in a College Credit Course @ Kirkwood CC

Kirkwood Community College (KCC) refers to college credit courses as Alternative Concurrent Enrollment Courses.

- 1. Discuss your plans with Mrs. Anderson.
 - How will these courses transfer? Use this <u>link</u> to see an example.
- 2. If you haven't already, apply to earn college credit in high school at KCC. (It's free!) https://www.kirkwood.edu/hscreditapply
- 3. Establish your "k"number, your password and your KCC email account.
 - Use this <u>information</u> to identify your next steps to becoming a college student!
 - Make sure to set up your KCC email account and check it often! The only way
 KCC shares information is through your KCC email account.
- **4. Decide which courses work for you.** Once you have established your "k" number password and set-up your KCC email account, you can select courses.
 - Schedule a time to meet with Mrs. Anderson to talk about courses.
 - You can go directly to KCC Dual Enroll. Log-In.
 - Once in Dual Enroll, you can search for course(s).
 - Once you find a course, select the Register button. Selecting the register button does not register you in the course. Mrs. Anderson, however, will see the course(s) you want to take and she will be the person to approve the course(s).
 - i. For students wanting to take a course in the fall, KCC typically releases a schedule of courses after spring break.
 - ii. For students wanting to take a course in the spring, KCC typically releases a schedule of courses in mid-October.
- 5. Take placement tests. (if necessary) Placement scores are required for students wanting to take a KCC Math Courses.
 - ACT Scores can be used for course placement. If a student does not have ACT Scores, the student will need to take the ALEKS Test (placement test for Math).
- 6. Remember to set-up your "k" number, your password and your KCC email.
