Thank you for participating in our volunteer-run league's first online tournament! It's exciting that even during the COVID-19 pandemic, students can continue to improve as speakers and listeners. We value education over competition and want all students (novice and varsity) to find their voices and to listen mindfully.

[GGSA Congress 1 Parli 1 Main Website](#) includes the registration information and informative links on the yellow side panel. At the same time as our Congress tournament, there is a Parliamentary Debate tournament occurring.

In order to provide secure, efficient virtual spaces for online tournaments, our league has contracted with 3 online platforms. It is important that you consult the linked video tutorials and documents to become familiar with the necessary technology. Please practice logging in and navigating the websites. Remember:

1. *Tabroom.com* - tabroom.com shows you where to go each round
2. *Classrooms.cloud* - tournaments.classrooms.cloud provides access to your competition room
 - If you are asked to login, use the email address and password you used to register at tabroom.com along with that password.
3. *Zoom.us* - within tournaments.classrooms.cloud the zoom app will be launched to communicate with the other participants.

Key items for judges:

- You will find out your judge assignment and room assignment on tabroom.com.
- Access the online competition rooms in tournaments.classrooms.cloud.
- Open the zoom app to watch the round in gallery view.
 - Note zoom password (in tournaments.classrooms.cloud virtual competition room)
- Judge/score your round on your online ballot in tabroom.com.
 - In www.tabroom.com, You will be asked to **RATE** each speech 3-6 and provide comments to the individual student. At the end of the round, you will **RANK** the students 1-9 and leave the rest blank so they receive 10th place. The 4 students in each chamber with the lowest score (think golf scoring) will receive awards. If your chamber has two students taking turns as Presiding Officer, you will follow a Google Form link on your ballot and vote for the best Presiding Officer.
- If you are asked to login to https://tournaments.classrooms.cloud, use the email address you used to register at tabroom.com along with that password.
- If you use the Zoom app instead of the browser, you'll need to change your name to Judge -- Full Name.
