

Skutt Catholic Uniform Dress Code

Students in Catholic schools wear uniforms for important reasons: economy, a level of “reasonableness” in choice of attire, and as a component of the strong discipline for which students and parents choose Catholic schools. Uniforms help ensure that clothing does not become a distraction to the learning environment of the school. The uniform is a symbol of the community that all students in our Catholic schools share. Uniforms are not meant to suppress individuality; rather, the wearing of a uniform frees students to demonstrate their individuality at the most-meaningful levels: through their efforts, personality, spirituality and service to others. Non-compliance with uniform dress code may require students to go home to retrieve compliant clothing or require a parent/guardian to deliver compliant clothing to school.

- Polo
 - white or black
 - embroidered Skutt Catholic logo
 - purchased from the uniform section of the HawkNest
- Skirts (girls only)
 - Skutt Catholic approved plaid
 - purchased from the uniform section of the HawkNest
 - the bottom hem of the skirt must be longer than the wearer’s fingertips when their arms are at rest at their side
 - girls with non-compliant skirts will be required to lengthen the skirt or replace it within a designated time.
- Pants (boys or girls)
 - solid black, solid khaki, or solid gray
 - straight cut
 - five pocket (jean style) or cargo pants (image below) are not permissible
 - pockets
 - on seam side pockets
 - welt style back pockets (with or without buttons)
 - must have belt loops
 - length must reach the student’s ankle bone (when standing)
 - bottom hem must be loose fitting around the ankle (no joggers)
- Shorts (boys or girls)
 - may be worn from the start of school through the end October and from the first day of school following Spring Break through the end of the school year
 - solid black or solid khaki or solid gray
 - the bottom hem of the shorts must be longer than the wearer’s fingertips when their arms are at rest at their side
 - Students with non-compliant length shorts will be required to lengthen the shorts or replace them within a designated time.
 - must have belt loops
 - on seam side pockets
 - welt style back pockets (with or without buttons)
 - cargo shorts are not permissible
- Sweatshirts (hoodie or crew neck)

- gray, black, or white SC branded logo only
 - purchased from the uniform section of the HawkNest
 - all sweatshirts must have a uniform polo worn underneath at all times
- Quarter Zips
 - gray, black, or white SC branded logo only
 - purchased from the uniform section of the HawkNest
 - all quarter zips must have a uniform polo worn underneath at all times

Only Acceptable Logos for Sweatshirts and Quarter Zips



- Sweaters
 - solid black, solid gray, solid green, or solid burgundy
 - v-neck or cardigan style
 - purchased from the uniform section of the HawkNest
 - all sweaters must have a uniform polo worn underneath at all times
- Socks
 - socks must be worn at all times
 - socks must be visible
- Belts
 - a belt must be worn with pants and shorts at all times
- Shoes
 - shoes must be worn at all times

In School Uniform Expectations (includes formal school uniform items)

- Hair must be a natural color and a reasonable length and style
- Facial hair is prohibited
- Only solid white T-shirts may be worn under polos
- Polos must be tucked in
- Remove all outerwear e.g. jackets, coats, scarves
- No hats, sunglasses, scarves or distracting accessories
- No non-uniform approved Skutt Catholic sweatshirts, pullovers, jackets, hoodies, etc.
- Only leggings/tights may be visible under skirts
 - Leggings/tights must be ankle length and be solid black or solid gray in color
 - Students may not wear loose fitting garments, e.g. sweatpants, joggers, pajama pants
