A right of reply may be granted at the discretion of the Dais if a remark is deemed to have impugned the territorial integrity of a representative's state. If a delegate believes that this circumstance applies, this form must be completed and submitted to the Dais. Please ensure that you write out your speech in its entirety below. If the right of reply is granted, the Dais will read the reply to the committee.

Explanation of the Rule

If a remark impugns the integrity of a representative's state, the President may permit that representative to exercise their right of reply following the conclusion of the controversial speech, and shall determine an appropriate time limit for the reply. No ruling on this question shall be subject to appeal.

For purposes of this rule, a remark that impugns the integrity of a representative's state is one directed at the governing authority of that state and/or one that puts into question that state's sovereignty or a portion thereof. All interventions in the exercise of the right of reply shall be addressed in writing to the Secretariat and shall not be raised as a point of order or motion. Only upon approval of the Secretariat shall the right of reply be read to the Committee, and in no case after voting has concluded on all matters relating to the agenda topic, during the discussion of which, the right arose. The right of reply will not be approved should it impugn the integrity of another state.
