- 2:15 <u>Formal response</u> to actions taken by the Board of Trustees on 6/22 to require the college to place a notation in the College Catalog promoting a certificate of achievement that has not yet been developed
 - After discussion and collaboration, a motion was made to sign this letter from the Curriculum
 Committee and to forward it to the Academic Senate Executive, DCC, and World Languages Department,
 as well as any other interested CCSF groups, for their support and signature before it is delivered to the
 Board of Trustees.

- 3:20 Financial Aid: The Ripple of Effect of Program Changes (Guillermo's slideshow)
 - Guillermo's slideshow, linked above, brought attention to the importance of communicating and
 documenting unit and name changes with certificates of achievement so as to not be subject to an audit
 or have to return money to the Department of Education. It's especially important that department
 chairs are aware of changes so that they can communicate with the Financial Aid Office in a timely
 manner. Processing can take a few months, so the deadline for reporting is near the end of spring
 semester.

3:45 CurrlQunet updates

- DEA approval workflow
 - As part of our effort to make CurrlQunet better address our needs, the DEA approval workflow has been updated, as show in the link above.
- Renaming proposal types
 - <u>Compare the alternatives</u>, keeping in mind that the type appears in the first proposal steps, atop individual CQnet pages in big orange letters, and in exported reports.
 - The committee decided to use the language in column 3. Still, to avoid proposal options beginning with "deactivation," the different types will be grouped by a letter-number combination (e.g., A3). The phrasing in column 3 will also be applied to program proposals.
- Work experience hours-units ratio will be changing, meaning our outlines will as well.
- 4:00 <u>Legislative Update with Rachel Cohen</u>: GE Movie Afternoon <u>slideshow</u>
 - See slideshow for details. Rachel reviewed CalGETC changes and introduced the potential benefits of mirroring the CalGETC GE structure and doing so for fall '24 instead of fall '25 to streamline restructuring and renaming efforts. E.g., renaming CCSF's lettered areas with CalGETC's area numbers 1-6. Discussion will continue at the next meeting, especially regarding questions about units students must take with current CCSF GE areas F, G1, and G2. These are not GE areas at mother colleges, and in some instances a student might be taking an extra 10 units in order to fulfill these CCSF requirements. As is, these areas cannot be double-dipped into other CCSF GE areas, and the 1-3 unit description is misleading since there are combinations of 7 units for both G1 and G2. This merits deeper discussion with departments.
- 4:25 H1, H2, and H3 courses that will need expedited changes for fall '24 (follow-up from the 8/16 meeting)
 - Map CQnet for CSU Area F and new CCSF H
 - Will CCSF accept courses as ES GE locally if those courses have not been accepted as ES GE by CSU?
 - Consider <u>Ethnic Studies</u> criteria
 - Use this time to revise GE Area letters/numbers so that they match CalGETC?
 - There was not enough time to sincerely discuss criteria for local Ethnic Studies courses beginning fall '24. More time will be devoted at the next meeting. Here is the big issue: Because the CCC has not yet committed to criteria for Ethnic Studies courses or clarified if ETHN may be used for crosslisted courses, would it make sense for CCSF's local Ethnic Studies courses to be the 21+ currently approved for CalGETC (CSU Area F)? What about Ethnic tcourses recently rejected by CSU reviewers for their Area F even though those courses mirror the 21+ already approved by CSU?
