Students and their families should read and understand the following expectations to apply to the Trimble County Virtual Program. Please initial or **answer yes or no** for each statement listed below. If at any time you check no, please stop the application. This application should be done with your child. The **parent and child** must agree to all of the following and sign the application at the end.

To be accepted into a virtual school, previous years' grades matter. If your child has more than one F from the previous year, then he or she may not be a candidate. We will be looking at "each child individually" to make this decision, and the committee will determine eligibility.

I understand that my child has to have a consistent, reliable internet. **Phone hotspot will not work.** (For example, can your internet stream YouTube or Netflix without buffering?)

I understand that my child will maintain daily progress in Edgenuity in all courses and must maintain passing grades in all courses. I understand that I must monitor my child's daily progress in all courses. They cannot be red in any courses. If they have red in any course, they must come into school and work until the red has turned into blue or green.

I understand that if I get a call from the coordinator, saying my child must come in to work in the Virtual Lab, this is **non-negotiable**.

I understand that my child must check their email daily and should respond to all teacher correspondence the same day it is sent.

I understand that students must come to the school to take the following tests in person: iREADY testing (if in grades 7-10), End-of-the-Year state testing, ACT or SAT (depending on what is adopted by the State), and cumulative testing in Edgenuity.

All finals of every course must be taken in the school, as well as state testing. Most of this testing happens three times a year.

I understand that if my child requires speech or special education services, then my child will be required to meet with the teachers via Google Meet according to their IEP or 504.

NOTE: An ARC will be required before transitioning to the Trimble County Virtual Program.
