Terms and Conditions – Day Retreat

Overview

This retreat offers a range of supervised, values-based activities designed to support spiritual development. These may include mindful yoga, kirtan, arts and crafts, cooking vegetarian meals aligned with Hindu values, caring for cows, and guided visits around Bhaktivedanta Manor. All activities are led by responsible supervisors, and children will be supported throughout.

Health, Safety & Welfare

- The safety and wellbeing of all participants is a priority. Children are expected to follow all instructions given by organisers during activities.
- Parents/guardians remain responsible for their children before arrival and after departure (unless they are travelling by coach, in which case they will be supervised by a responsible adult).
- Any medical conditions, allergies (including food or animal-related), or additional needs must be shared in advance so appropriate care can be provided. In the event of an emergency, consent is given for basic first aid or necessary medical treatment.
- Children will only be supervised if they remain within the specified areas during the retreat. Pandava Sena will not be held accountable for any incidents if children leave designated areas within the buildings or grounds where activities are taking place.
- During the cooking workshop, all participants are expected to behave responsibly and follow the instructions and safety guidance given by supervisors at all times. Pandava Sena will not accept responsibility for any injury, damage, or harm caused as a result of a participant failing to follow instructions or behaving unsafely during the workshop.

Behaviour & Expectations

- We aim to create a respectful environment for everyone. Participants are expected to treat others with kindness, behave appropriately, and show respect to organisers, the space, and the values of the retreat.

- Children should remain within designated areas unless supervised and must be honest about their age and any relevant information.
- To maintain the ethos of the retreat, participants are not permitted to bring items such as alcohol, cigarettes or vaping products, illegal substances, weapons, or any non-vegetarian food (including meat or eggs).

Responsibility and Media Consent

- Participants are responsible for their personal belongings, and the organisers cannot accept liability for loss or damage.
- Pandava Sena does not take responsibility for any incidents that occur as a result of children not adhering to the rules set out by organisers.
- Photos and videos may be taken during the retreat for promotional purposes. By allowing your child to attend, you give consent for this.

Fees & Bookings

- Full payment is required to secure a place. Bookings are non-refundable except in exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the organisers.
- If a participant does not follow the rules or behaves in a way that disrupts the safety or experience of others, organisers reserve the right to remove them from the retreat. In such cases, no refund will be given.
