#### 1. Apply to SBCC

- You must apply to Santa Barbara City College
- You may apply to SBCC online at <u>SBCC.edu</u>

### 2. Culinary Cohort

 You must email <u>saalvarez4@pipeline.sbcc.edu</u> for information about the program and to be put in the Culinary cohort. Please send her you name and Student ID #, K# and request program information.

#### 3. Register for Classes

- You must be registered in, and/or have passed (C or better), CA 113 Hospitality
