- Goal: To provide students an environment in which they can learn to work with Web 2.0 by using the contemporary Internet services to be able to create and share the content and participate in it with the others.
- Objective: To learn to create proper blogging posts and comments based on the contemporary Internet rules and netiquette.
- Age of students: 11 15 (Grade 6 9: middle school students or first grade high school students)
- <u>Description</u>: Students create blog posts on topics given by their teachers and share them with the community of students from the participating schools (see below).
 - They also comment on the posts of the other students or reply to the comments on their own posts. The system is accessible only for these students, their teachers and parents.
