[Mobile Scoring](#) – Each station should have one volunteer using a smartphone to conduct mobile scoring. This tool is ONLY available on the day of the competition. Please follow the steps below to conduct the scoring:

1. Go online to your web browser (Safari or Google) and type in scoring.drivechipandputt.com – press enter to search and open the event scoring tool
2. Select the event – White Lake Golf Club
3. Enter the Access Code: Michigan25 - If you don't know your code, please ask the PGA professional.
4. Type in your first and last name, click submit
5. Select the skill that you are assigned to from the home screen (Drive, Chip, or Putt)
6. Select the division (our events ALWAYS start with Boys 14-15)
7. Click on the player's name that is conducting the skill and enter the points as each attempt is performed
8. To get to the next player, you may either hit the "next player" button in the bottom right hand corner, or hit the back button and select the next player.

Remember to ALWAYS verify who the player is before scoring their attempts in the scoring tool.

What to Bring:

- Snacks, water, or a small cooler
- An umbrella or rain gear in case of inclement weather
- Hand sanitizer - will be provided
