6. Find a piece of evidence from each of your classes this year that you are most proud of and add it to your new portfolio.

Evidence Collection: CLE

Evidence must be something you can see or experience that shows what you have been doing. It can be a picture, video, assignment, audio recording or a **detailed** explanation of an experience. Your evidence must show each of the following, demonstrating;

- ★ what you have learned,
- ★ what you are proud of,
- ★ where you are going.

Remember

- Each piece of evidence should have **Teacher Tags** included which are connected to the Provincially-outlined Core Competencies (see the link below for more information explaining what these are all about).
- Each piece of evidence should have a **2-3 sentence reflection** on what the evidence was from and why you feel it was important and meaningful. (see above example)
