




Vocabulary List – Modifications for Learning

Students may need some additional support with what is built. Here are some suggested ways for teachers to make modifications **before** sharing with your students:

- 1) **Create** your **Vocabulary List** using the Vocabulary List tool.
(Highlight the words you want included in your list with one of our highlighting colors and click on the Vocabulary List icon.)
- 2) **Change the new** Vocabulary List from portrait **to landscape**.
- 3) **Change the title** of the **Notes** column **to My Definitions or another category** listed below.
- 4) **Create/add a 5th column** to the far right or even a 6th column.
- 5) **Choose** from the following categories **to title your last column**:
 - Definitions
 - Images/Pictures
 - Examples
 - Comparisons
 - Context Sentences
 - Category (is a part of)
 - Real World Connections

Word	Meaning	Symbol	My Definitions	Examples
habitat	the type of environment in which an organism or group normally lives or occurs; "a marine habitat"; "he felt safe on his home grounds"			
perils	a source of danger; a possibility of incurring loss or misfortune; "drinking alcohol is a health hazard" pose a threat to; present a danger to; "The pollution is endangering the crops"			
dehydration	the process of extracting moisture dryness resulting from the removal of water depletion of bodily fluids			
grunt	the short low gruff noise of the kind made by hogs issue a grunting, low, animal-like noise; "He grunted"
