#### III. <u>DEI Coaching Program</u> (20 mins)

- This program has been running for almost one year
- DEI coaches are faculty across the Twin Cities, there is one coach in DU, hope to have a SC coach in the future
- Some coaches have a small FTE, some are volunteers
- Discussions on the various reasons to refer a student to a DEI coach
- Approximately 17 students have reached out so far, the majority identifying as BIPOC and in their 3rd year.
- Career guidance has been the most popular encounter topic, followed by Step 1 and navigating medical school in general.

• Forthcoming outcome measures: 3rd year students participating currently will be taking the GQ survey next year. This program will also be included in the annual advising survey in the Spring.

### IV. <u>Foundations Curriculum update</u> (10 mins)

- Almost at the end of the first complete run-through of the Foundations phase of the curriculum
- Jess discussed the various ways of collecting student feedback, emphasizing that it is the main driver of change in the curriculum
- Changes made based on student feedback
  - Discontinued in-person zoom connections between campus
  - Course directors on each campus for every course
  - More incorporation of Uworld questions in sessions and pre-quizzes
  - More facilitators in TC in person sessions
  - Thread Student Lead positions added
  - o Improved, better aligned PBL assessments
- We will learn more after the 2027 class takes Step 1 in the Spring about the effects of the recent curriculum adjustments.
