For the first time ever in a Disney theme park is the American Dragon, Jake Long! You can meet Jake, in his dragon form, outside the Chinese Theater, utilizing the outdoor standby queue for Mickey and Minnie's Runaway Railway (to enter the attraction, guests will have to use the Lightning Lane entrance). Jake stands in front of a backdrop of his grandfather's shop, as seen in the show. Feel free to stop by and say hello... that is, if you're not a member of the Hunstclan!

Playhouse Disney

Disney Junior Theater



The young at heart can *go, go-go-go, go-go-a-go* visit the Playhouse Disney friends they grew up with at - appropriately enough - the current *Disney Junior Dance Party!* theater. A quarter of the building has been dressed up as the playhouse they may recognize from the block's early 2000s interstitials and promos, with a few Easter Eggs referencing the block's hosts - if you look closely, you can a picture of Ooh and Aah hanging up on the wall, as well as a small model of Clay sitting on a cabinet. Here you can share a hug or take a photo with JoJo and Goliath from *JoJo's Circus*, the Little Einsteins, Handy Manny, Rolie Polie Olie, and Stanley. The stage area, meanwhile, is occupied by a replica of the Big Blue House from, well, *Bear in the Big Blue House* (with Tutter, Pip, Pop, Ojo, and Treelo occasionally peeking out the windows) and Bear is standing outside ready to meet you - making his grand return to the park for the first time since 2008. This meet and greet is sure to bring back fond memories.

Commissary Lane Garage




Meet LizzieMcGuire, the quintessential early 2000s Disney Channel girl! Before Sonny with a Chance, before Wizards of Waverly Place, before Hannah Monatana: there was Lizzie. A simple sitcom about an average high school girl and her friends going through sitcom hijinks and misadventures that every teen, tween, or pre-teen could relate to. All alongside a little animated version of herself who would appear in cutaway gags as the personification of her inner thoughts (functioned similarly to the "diary room talking straight to camera" moments that shows like the Office or Modern family has).

This meet & greet will serve as a sort of two for one special as Lizzie herself will be a face character, but screens hidden around the set will feature the animated version of Lizzie (which has pre-recorded dialogue and pre-made animations triggered by a digital puppeteer nearby sort of like a simplified Turtle Talk). Housed in the Commissary Lane Garage, the interior will be designed to resemble Lizzie's room giving guests a nostalgic peak into what life was like for kids back in the early 2000s. Adding an extra pop of color (and hiding the screens for the animated Lizzie) will be brightly colored pink, green, and orange cartoon flowers all around the room.

Getting to meet live action and animated Lizzie McGuire at the same time?

Clearly, this is what dreams are made of!





Penny & Oscar Proud


Grand Avenue
