Rainbow Cookies

- 1 C. Butter
- 3/4 C. Brown Sugar
- 3/4 C. Granulated Sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 1 tsp. Vanilla
- 3 1/4 C. Flour
- 1/2 tsp. Baking Soda
- 1/2 tsp. Salt

Food Coloring for a rainbow, red, orange, yellow, green, blue and violet

- 1. Mix butter and sugars for four minutes with whip attachment.
- 2. Add eggs one at a time to butter mixture. Then add vanilla.
- 3. Put all dry ingredients in a bowl.
- 4. Change out the whip attachment for the paddle attachment.
- 5. Gradually add flour mixture to cookie dough. This dough is stiff. Make sure to add all flour.
- 6. Divide the dough into six equal parts.
- 7. Mix one color into each of the dough balls.
- 8. Once color is mixed in, wrap the dough in a parchment paper.
- 9. Place in the refrigerator for 2 hours or overnight.
- 10. When you are ready to make the cookies, preheat oven to 350°.
- 11. Roll out each color into a long rectangle, 4 5 inches wide and 18-24 long.
- 12. Stack each color on top of each other. The color order starting from the bottom is, purple, blue, green, yellow, orange and red on top.
- 13. Trim the edges and then cut across the rectangle.

- 14. Bend the cookie dough into a rainbow shape and place on a greased cookie sheet for a large cookie. Cut in half for a smaller cookie.
- 15. Use the back of a spatula to push cookie flat.
- 16. Bake for 14 minutes for big cookies and 10 minutes for smaller cookies.
