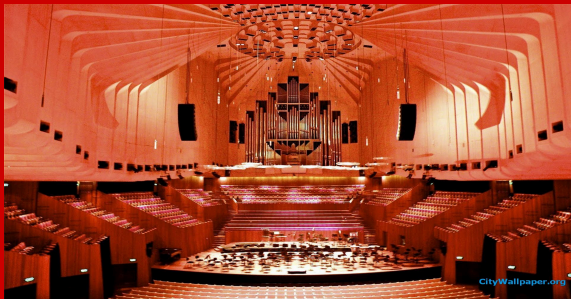


-Sydney Opera

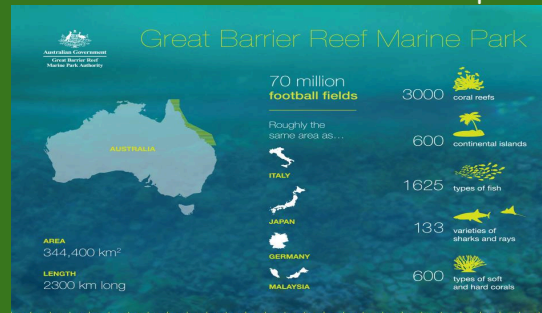

The opera house has also won architecture's highest award. For special events the domes of the building can light up and show beautiful artwork.



-Great Barrier

Off the coast of Queensland, Australia you can visit the world's largest living thing. At over 2300 kilometers long, the reef is host to 100's of islands and 600 plus



types of coral. You can see fish, dolphins, turtles and sharks while you're there. The reef is so large that it is visible from space with an area of 134,286 mi²! You can even scuba-dive, snorkel, swim with dolphins, and take a helicopter tour over more than 3000 reef systems.



-Darling Harbour-

The Darling Harbour is adjacent to the city center of Sydney, Australia. There is a large pedestrian and recreational precinct which holds large events. Surrounding the square is a large shopping mall and a



national maritime museum. If you have children, the harbour also has a 9D theater and ride show. For those that enjoy foliage and flowers, there is a Chinese garden. On the water, there is an aqua cafe, water taxis, and cruises to many places or for any occasion.
