3. A school book fair sold 31 chapter books and 7 picture books. How many books were sold in all?
4. Priya has 10 marbles in her collection. If she gives 6 marbles to her best friend, how many marbles will she have left?
5. Alyssa picked 23 limes and Nancy picked 38 limes from the lime tree. How many limes were picked in total?
6. After a forest fire, there are 18 old trees, plus 3 baby trees called saplings. How many trees are there overall?
7. There are 7 pencils in the drawer. Tim took 2 pencils out of the drawer. How many pencils are there now?
8. Benny had 6 \$1 coins in his coin pouch. His sister borrowed 2 of his \$1 coins. How many coins does Benny have now?
9. Jared is reading a book that has a total of 89 pages. So far, he has read 9 pages. How many pages does Jared have left to read?
10. Patrick is building a cabinet. He needs 22 two-and-a-half-centimetre bolts and 5 two-centimetre bolts. How many bolts in all does Patrick need?
