Century High School Football parent committee "Century Community Football - CHS Football Boosters" provides leadership and opportunity to support football athletes and coaches in fundraisers and activities that both students and parents may choose to participate in.

Century Community Football provides many opportunities for fundraisers and activities throughout the year, information is sent home via email as well as posted on our Website www.ccfboosters.org and SignUpGenius.

At least one adult must be present and supervising ALL events! Continuous adult oversight and supervision is necessary for any opportunity to take place.

Tax Exempt, Non-Profit Status

Century Community Football is a non-profit 501(c)(3). Donations of any size are welcome – every bit helps and all donations are tax deductible. Receipts for amounts over \$250.00, as required by law and as requested, will be gratefully supplied to the donating party.

Adult/Parent Volunteer Hours

To encourage active support and participation of all parents in necessary football functions and activities, families are required to contribute **16 Adult/Parent Volunteer Hours per school year**. These hours will be applied and tracked per family, not per student. If one family has multiple students participating in football, their family obligation will only be 16 hours. The Adult/Parent Volunteer Hours will be charged on the oldest students account.

A \$160 fee will be added to 1 student account per family August 15 or at the time a new student is added. For each hour an Adult/Parent volunteers, \$10.00 will be credited towards this fee. When the allotted 16 hours is complete, this fee will be considered paid in full. Additional hours are highly encouraged and welcomed, we need volunteers to make this program a success. Volunteer hours may be done throughout the entire current school year, but must be completed by November 30th. Hours tracked and recorded are for the current school year only. We do not back date volunteer hours for previous years. The volunteer hours and fees will be managed by Century High School Football Boosters - Century Community Football. www.ccfboosters.org
