6.0 Notice of Motions

6.1 - Notice re: Clubs Hub

- -Space director presenting: proposal regarding funds for improvements of club hub. Where clubs store items and work together. Workstations inefficient and strong lack of work space, what he is addressing the most. New space involves large conference area + more storage, also looking to renting the space. Furniture mostly canadian furnitures, addition of new TVs to facilitate group work, lockers + new screen + shelfing unit in east wing; whiteboard + workstations; new lockers (clubs have concerns for storing their stuff); Timeline: end everything on the 3rd of March hopefully. Budget: a very conservative one, **15'046\$**, if equivalent products are cheaper, will take those instead.
- -Nick: Two benches are of a total of 1100, so they could easily be replaced for a cheaper one.
- -Armaan: what about cleaning out in time? → Nick and Sarah have a game plan in which clubs will have a space to put their stuff in the meantime
- -JL: Discuss it between departments, and email JHan for questions so that next time we can vote on it

6.2 - Notice re: Painting & Card Reader

- **-Malcolm presenting:** Lots of walls and doors in the EUS mall (see details in council folder)will be painted and have new logos. The reason why it's so expensive is that McGill has rules on how we can renovate spaces.
- **-Luke:** When will they paint? → They will paint from 5:30pm to 9pm, services will continue with normal operating hours, mostly things don't need to move, just need to move the fridge and rack of candies
- -Grace: Who gets card access for the committee room? → We need to discuss that, the idea behind card readers is that everybody has access right now, so ideally all engineering students with specific hours, but not agreed on it yet.
- -Dow: Who approves the access? → Not VP Services
- -Armaan: Committee room will be accessible to all eng. Students (Security issues)? → Mitch: Nothing is safe anyway, priority is to fix the safe access, we could always add lockers. Times and who has access is something to be discussed.

Kareem: Suggestion → Function according to applications Erin: Another option is to also have no name key cards

New business

6.3 - Motion re: Updating Constitution of CEUS

-John: Goal is to update it since it's been quite a while (2012). Existing constitution doesn't actually reflect

the actual duties.

- -Dow: motion to amend article 7.1: add after trusteeship in brackets "under the engineering undergraduate Society" → Because you want the funds to stay within Engineering and not fall into the hands possibly of McGill and get put towards non-civil engineering students.
- -JL: Is there a referendum for the constitution? → Amendment has to go through a GA according to the Constitution; Refer to JL for any help→ motion out of order

6.4 - Motion re: VP Student Life

- **-Nick:** Basically updating his position in the constitution. Essentially to make these changes so that people who apply this position know about the new rules, needs to go through a referendum first, but he wants us to discuss it over first. New are in italic; adding grad com, mental health, SEAM, JC and any recruitments stuff for 15.1.1. 15.1.2; for people to get more involved. All points in color are up for discussion/debate.
- **-Dow:** 15.1.6, did the presidents get any departmental reports from your predecessors? → Some are yes and no; maybe that article should be delegated to president of society.

Sarah: It would be nice of EUS could provide those "templates" for transitions, if EUS is involved if the covered documention is ensured, then there is no blanks left. Applies to clubs and committees.

- -Armaan: Agrees, needs to gather reports for departments, clubs and committees? → JL: would be relevant to put the President to ensure the transition, but not the clubs (just the department). Student life position is to give it the opportunity to grow.
- **-Maxence:** Concerning end of year reports, things like committees reports should be inforced with whoever's portfolio it falls under, it shouldn't be centralized.
- -Malcolm: Concerning the transitions, there's a lot of committees and clubs and removing and adding, i'm just worried that you might be working with all of these and the roles, leading towards just you delegating only. → Nick: clubs and design teams are pretty independent, committees are different.
- **-JL:** 15.1.6 either we strike it down, or put it under the president's tasks. → Dow: would it be logical to strike it and add it under 15.1.8?

Dow: Motion to strike 15.1.6 regarding departmental societies and to add under 15.1.8 the responsibility of collecting End of Year reports for EUS Clubs. Noted by Pauline (referred to by Dow) that this created a grey hole since the Design Teams have a different definition that clubs and therefore would need to be included in new clauses 15.1.10 and 15.1.11, these will be added at a future date.

-Yannis: this conversation is running in a corner and leading between four people

6.5 - Motion re: Common Room Booking Policy

-Erin: We won't be charging for the room anymore, not huge revenu anyways → Big modification here. Smaller things were to increase the damage policy, which doesn't even cover a broken chair. Added a clause about the keys.

Seconded by Maxence

- -Jessica McAvoy: What about blood drive? Cleaning fee? → That never had to do with the booking charge anyways, if there is a fee, it's not really a booking fee but a renting fee
- -Sarah: Maybe make a point that clubs reserving and not actually using the room, complaints about that space? → Complaints were more for infosys compared to committee room, it's a general practice not to make people do repeated bookings, it confuses everyone that might be trying to book something, don't know might be something to be added in the policy → Can be more discussed

-Liam: Can external groups book it whenever they want then free of charge? → Will still let them, but if there is a fee it's for like projector, but it still goes through the same process, no fees, priority for EUS.

6.7 - Motion re: EUSF Surplus Plan

- -Katherine: Not changing bylaws of EUSF, just to let us know what's happening. 1- dealing with EUSF surplus and with what we can potentially do, is to put it in the student initiative funds. Would be a fixed way to how it can be used (e.g. hiring a new prof). If there isn't a clear plan on how it's used, more on the student initiative funds, moved away from faculty and more for students. 2- decreased fee for students paying EUSF, because it was at the time for the need of the cuts, wasn't actually implemented clearly because of transitioning problem, shouldn't be charging students with money going to faculty. EFS gets allocated on a postdated schedule, meaning the we collect the money for EFC, and then allocate it for the 2017-2018 year (following year), EUSF collects the money and allocates the money. In the past did it earlier, did not realize it was a surplus (170K), so we were actually allocating it wrong → wants to allocating it according to EFC, so that TAs get hired and prof gets planning before they are actually teaching. Using the surplus to smooth the transition, allocating before the semester starts, and once we have gotten into the rotation, start putting the surplus into the student initiative funds. It is complicated, but will be doing a presentation to the VP academics so they can brief us.
- -Pauline: So decreasing the fees, but are we increasing any other fees? → a decrease in 2.50\$ for MESC and for departments, MESC is able to absorb because of new funding of the DEAN and because of the margin of the surplus they have.
- -Yannis: Should actually do a survey about MESC how they're useful or not. For spending money, should actually know how the money is being used. → there is actually feedback
- **-Dimi:** is there data about the surplus? → yes it varies in the semesters
- **-Katherine:** the 170K is basically because of not using the departmental surplus and because it wasn't used for a whole semester
 - -Are you ok with decreasing the fee? → All in favor Will see a more proper presentation of it

6.8 - Motion re: Congress Committee Creation

- **-Jess:** Went to congress 2017 and put in a bid to host 2019 at McGill, so now want to formally create a committee and start selecting our chairs
- -Armaan: how forming committee? → Selcom, applications going out next week
- **-JL:** Amendment: be it resolved that it's a standing committee, because a regular one would be more complicated and "open a whole new door".

6.9 - discussion re: bioeng meeting

- **-Itai:** want to have a meeting to discuss details over constitution, would like to set a date to discuss it. Suggestions on suggesting a date would be to do it next week.
- -Katherine: Suggested to do a google form to do a standing committee.

7.1 - Engineering Senator

make exams less difficult; senator election will be taking place with the execs, event for the info session posted in the EUS group; UHSC has postponed smoking policy for McGill, will be coming back for approval.

-Ameer: SSMU funding? → Niall was supposed to give a presentation, but he never answered, so funding committee has been really behind.

8.0 Reports from departmental societies

8.1 - Architecture (1 min)
