 - CSF contains \$55,000, in addition to some funds carried over from the previous year.
- The Community Enhancement and Emergency Fund (CEEF) funds student-led projects to enhance and upgrade the campus, benefiting the entire student body.
 - In the past, CEEF has funded the following projects: Accessibility Ramp at the BCC, Branda, Library Treadmills, Condom Dispensers, and more.
 - CEEF has a budget of \$250,000 from the SAF.

CEEF and CSF Funding Results

Overall Results- Redid the Funding Scope

- → Cut funding scope to 7 pages, down from 14
- → Removed redundancies and updated for new procedures

Community Emergency and Enhancement Fund (CEEF) Funding Results from 2024 Applications:

- ➤ <u>Undergraduate Transportation Fund:</u> \$6,000 was allocated to assist students with commuting to and from off-campus internships and jobs. Students will be granted up to \$100 each to cover transportation costs to and from Boston for the duration of the semester.
- ➤ <u>I AM BRANDEIS Pt. 2:</u> Nearly \$4,000 was allocated to build and supply dispensers around campus with free menstrual products for students. This constitutes Pt. 2 of an ongoing collaboration between the Brandeis University Student Union and the PAD club on campus.
- ➤ <u>Brandeis Stair Accessibility Improvement Project:</u> More than \$35,000 was allocated to install high-visibility/grit strips on hundreds of stairs across campus to improve accessibility and make campus safer for those with disabilities.
- ➤ <u>Brandeis Event Ease:</u> More than \$1,000 of funding was allocated for club resource carts to help clubs move materials around campus more efficiently. The carts will help clubs transport materials for shows, installations, and cultural events.
- ➤ <u>Focus Pods:</u> Nearly \$65,000 of funding was allocated to install state-of-the-art soundproof pods around campus, creating new spaces for students to take calls, meet virtually with employers, and conduct interviews in quiet and professional spaces.
- ➤ <u>Apple Vision Pro Spatial Tour:</u> More than \$10,000 of funding was allocated to purchase twoApple Vision Pros and develop augmented reality tours for admissions counselors on high school visits and at college fairs.
- ➤ <u>Pedestrian Campus Safety:</u> More than \$10,000 of funding was allocated to install pedestrian safety features at pedestrian crossings all around campus.

- ➤ <u>ICC Floor Renovation:</u> Nearly \$5,000 of funding to renovate the floor in the ICC and make the ICC a cleaner and safer space for students
- ➤ Campus Bleeding Control Station Coverage Expansion: Nearly \$7,500 of funding was allocated for an expansion of the current campus bleeding control program. The funding will go to installing dozens of bleeding control stations across campus.

Campus Sustainability Fund (CSF) Funding Results from 2024 Applications:

- → <u>Turkey Shuttles:</u> Helped students get to Penn Station and Logan Airport over Thanksgiving Break.
- → <u>Warming Stripes Banner Stakes:</u> Equipment to fix the Brandeis Warming Stripes Banner to the ground, when it used to take 10 people to hold.
- → <u>Brandeis Exchange Market Website:</u> Create an exchange similar to Facebook Marketplace for Brandeis students to reduce waste and promote sustainable practices.

Treasury Fall 2024

- > Held daily office hours
- ➤ Made 750+ payments this semester with clubs
- > A new spending system was implemented for the Student Union.
- > Held 4 large club treasurer trainings and 6 smaller focus sessions
