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Learn why the college application asks for my social security number (SSN)?	Colleges in Colorado ask for Social Security Numbers (SSNs) primarily for two reasons: to verify student identities and to comply with federal and state reporting requirements, particularly for financial aid and tax purposes. They use the SSN to match student records, ensure accurate tax reporting, and administer financial aid programs. Students who don't have a SSN can create a "C-Number", which allows them to participate in Concurrent Enrollment.
Learn more about the College Opportunity Fund (COF)?	The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is a trust fund created by the Colorado Legislature that provides a tuition stipend to eligible undergraduate students. The stipend pays a portion of your total in-state tuition when you attend a participating college. For more information, visit the College Opportunity Fund website.

This request must be made through your Student Email address to be considered official. Online classrooms and student tools such as Navigate should update to include your preferred name. Your legal name will still show in The Rock and on official RRCC documents such as transcripts.
