

## Putting Images on your Google Site with HTML



- You can display Images you find on the Internet or Images that you create with GIMP
- Go to your Google Site and create a new page called HTML pictures
- When you get to the page go to Table Insert Table then highlight 3 boxes. You will get 3 columns to
  insert pictures in. You could have added more rows and columns if you wanted to.
- Go to your Google Drive and click on an Image that you have uploaded to a Google doc
- Copy Image URL
- Then go back to your Google site click on one of the boxes and then on the <HTML> menu option
  above. Then using the HTML tag <img src =" "> put in you picture

## **Enter**

Insert the URL that you got for your picture. When you Update the page your picture should appear there.

You can also link to images on the Internet.

Find a picture you like on the Internet. Copy the Image URL. Go back to your Google Site and type in <img src ="http://static.zerochan.net/Donald.Duck.full.9190.jpg">

If you want to change the size just adjust the width with

Create pictures in all 3 boxes, sizing them with the width command so that they fit. You can also put text in the boxes below the pictures. Type <br/> to skip down a line then type in the text you want
